Introduction

Mambo/Sunga is a district in the Usambara Mountains in Tanzania. The area has about 20,000 inhabitants, spread over eight villages. Around 50% of the inhabitants is younger than 12 years old. Anno 2020, development is still essential at all levels and in almost every aspect. The vast majority of the people is living of agriculture. There is insufficient clean drinking water, poor education, poor health care and a lack of infrastructure.

Our goal

Our goal is to enhance the quality of life for the people living around Mambo. Not by aid, but by trade, education, transfer of knowledge and capacity building.

In order to reach this goal, we support JamiiSawa, a local Tanzanian foundation, by capacity building and funding. JamiiSawa serves as a platform and assists local people to take up their responsibilities and work together as a community, in order to outgrow poverty. JamiiSawa is active on a day to day basis in the projects we fund. We work together to improve **health care, education, infrastructure and entrepreneurship**.

Herman Erdtsieck and Marion Neidt started MamboViewPoint ecolodge in 2009, which serves as an economic base for local development in Mambo. MamboViewPoint shares our vision and mission and forms the base for JamiiSawa and our volunteers.
